Registration for the 2007/2008 season will begin soon. All registration forms are now available on our website at [www.bremertonice.com](http://www.bremertonice.com) . Please print out the registration forms under the "hockey registration" link. Also visit [www.usahockey.com](http://www.usahockey.com) and register each player for the 2007/2008 season. Please fill out all registration forms prior to registration day. We ask that when you come in to register that you bring in a copy of the participant's birth certificate and the confirmation printout that you receive after registering with USA Hockey. This confirmation number is required in order to register your player with KCHA for this next season. Registration for the 2007/2008 season will be conducted at the Bremerton Ice Skating Center on July 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>, 2007 from 5:30 to 9:00pm. After this date, all other registrations will be put on hold until we are able to guarantee availability unless special arrangements have been made with Floyd Johnson, Jeremy McCann, or Wes Travis. If you will not be in the area during registration, we ask that you notify us ahead of time.

For those who are going to tryout for the Midget B team, print and fill out a copy of the tryout form located on our website and bring it with you on **THE DAY OF TRYOUTS**. Participants in the B program **MUST** be prepared for a rigorous and challenging training environment as you will be competing for a State championship at the end of the year. Tryouts will be August 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>. Check in is a 2:30pm. Please bring the \$50 tryout fee at that time.

## **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

### **Initiation Program**

The IP program is designed for new players with little skating experience between the ages of 3 and 13. The goal of this program is to allow new players an opportunity to learn the basic fundamentals of the game prior to being placed on a league team. Players who progress through the season may have the opportunity to move onto a team once the player, family, and coaches feel comfortable with the transition and room is available prior to December 31<sup>st</sup>. Players will practice 1 day a week. Jerseys will be provided

### **Mite Minors**

The Mite Minors will be available for players 8 and under with basic hockey experience. Players in this division will practice once a week and play cross ice games through out the season on Saturdays. Most games will be played in house with the occasional game against another association. Jerseys and sox will be provided

### **Mite Major**

The Mite Major program is available for players 7-8 who have organized hockey experience; previous Mite player or last season Mini Mite who are capable of playing organized games of hockey. Mite teams will be given a schedule of at least 14 games through out the season and two practices a week. Games will be scheduled by The NPSHL (North Puget Sound Hockey League). Jerseys and sox will be provided

### **Squirt House Program**

The Squirt Program is available for players 10 and under who have some previous playing experience. Teams will be given a schedule of at least 14 games through out the season and two practices a week. Games will be played against other teams in Western Washington. All games will be scheduled by the NPSHL (North Puget Sound Hockey League). Jerseys and sox will be provided

### **Lady Outlaws**

The lady Outlaws will be made up of female hockey players between the ages of 7-19. The team will practice once a week and games will be scheduled by the team coach as desired. All efforts will be made to promote this program around the Puget Sound for additional games. Jerseys and sox will be an additional expense to the player

### **Squirt All Stars**

Our Squirt All stars will be comprised of those players who are playing squirt house hockey and have the ability and desire to play at a more competitive level. This team will have an additional practice every other Thursday night during the entire hockey season after the completion of tryouts. The Squirt All Stars will be responsible in scheduling their own games and/or tournaments through out the season on a not to interfere basis with the squirt house schedule. KCHA will only be charging those players who make the Squirt All stars for additional practices. Costs for all games and tournaments scheduled will be the responsibility of the team. Tryouts for Squirt All stars will be 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> of September and will cost \$50 for two separate on ice tryouts. Only players who attend the tryout will be considered for the Squirt All stars team roster. The team will be selected by the coaching staff and KCHA evaluators.

**Peewee House Program**

The Peewee House team will play in the North Puget Sound Hockey League. The NPSHL consists of teams from Seattle Junior, Seattle Junior Thunderbirds, Kent and Tacoma. The team will practice twice during the week throughout the season and play their league games on Saturday or Sunday. A game schedule will be created and released the first or second week of October by NPSHL officials. Jerseys and sox will be provided

**Bantam House Program**

The Bantam House team will play in the North Puget Sound Hockey League. The NPSHL consists of teams from Seattle Junior, Seattle Junior Thunderbirds, Kent and Tacoma. The team will practice twice during the week through out the season and play their league games on Saturday or Sunday. A game schedule will be created and released the first or second week of October by NPSHL officials. Jerseys and sox will be provided

**Bantam All Stars Program**

The Bantam All Stars will consist of players currently registered in the Bantam House Program. Players on this team will pay an additional \$225 and practice every other Thursday night starting at the completion of tryouts. The purpose of this team is to allow players with the ability to compete at a higher level an opportunity to do so. Additional games and tournaments shall be scheduled by the team staff. Games and tournaments are not included in the price of the team. The Bantam All Stars may have the ability to compete for the state championships at the end of the season if they meet all required qualifications and the team desires to compete. Any player wanting to be part of the All Star team must attend tryouts on the 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> of September. The cost will be \$50 for two tryouts. The team will be selected by the coaching staff and KCHA evaluators.

**Midget House Program**

The Midget House team plays in the North Puget Sound Hockey League. The NPSHL consists of teams from Everett, Seattle Junior, and Seattle Junior Thunderbirds. The team will practice twice during the week throughout the season and play their league games on Saturday or Sunday. A game schedule will be created and released the first or second week of October by NPSHL officials. Jerseys and sox will be provided

**Midget B**

All players must register for the KCHA hockey program as a Midget House player either on the 17<sup>th</sup> or 18<sup>th</sup> of July. Payment restructuring will be completed after the team is finalized. Any discounts will remain in effect for those qualifying for a discounted rate. The Midget B team will be hosting tryouts August 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>. Check in is at 2:30pm on the 11<sup>th</sup>. Please bring the \$50 tryout fee on Aug 11<sup>th</sup>. At the completion of tryouts, all players will be notified if they have made the team. Those not selected will be placed on the house team for the season. The Midget B team will practice three nights a week starting in September and games will be played in accordance with the PNAHA schedule. KCHA has no input on this PNAHA schedule. Players may qualify for regionals and nationals based on their performance. If the team qualifies for regionals or nationals, all additional costs must be paid for by the players on the team. This is subject to change pending the outcome of the PNAHA summer meeting. Jerseys and sox will be provided.
